WHO: 9 US Dental professionals & Moldovan counterparts; sponsored by ROTARY.

<u>WHAT</u>: Traveling to Moldova to provide free dental care to orphan and socially vulnerable children from Straseni and Chisinau.

WHEN: 15 - 22 March 2014

<u>WHERE</u>: DiaDent Private Clinic in Chisinau,

& Orphanages, Moldova.

<u>WHY</u>: Cumulating event for Dental relief effort begun in 2010 between NCARNG dentist and civilian volunteer dentist providing dental relief for disadvantaged children and empowering Moldovan civilian dentists to continue this effort.

RESULTS: This humanitarian mission provided dental care to over 100 disadvantaged children on this visit and over 3,100 children since 2010. This mission improved medical capabilities and services for the underserved population of Moldova. US Ambassador participated in the Rotary Chisinau Club meeting to celebrate the past 14 years of North Carolina State - Moldova Partnership and Rotary Clubs support for health care exchanges between Moldova and North Carolina.
