WHO: Three Moldovan Parliamentarians

WHAT: Visit to US under the US Dept of State's One World Program

WHEN: 12 May 2014

WHERE: Raleigh, NC

WHY: Promote strong US-Moldovan relations and to display to Moldovan officials how US government systems and relationships work

RESULTS: NCNG personnel briefed the Moldovan Parliamentarians (PMs) on the State Partnership Program, as well as how the NCNG supports the NC Emergency Management during domestic disasters.

Additionally, NCNG discussed with the Moldovan PMs the value of NonCommissioned officers in the US military and recommended that Moldova adopt a similar system with their military, but that this would require legislations.
